SURVIVE-MIVA is a Catholic lay Association and UK Registered Charity, founded in Liverpool, UK in 1974. It exists to provide one vital element for successful healthcare and pastoral work that is being carried out by the Church in areas of great need in Africa, Asia and Latin America: transport.
