Going into hospital and would like a visit from the RC Chaplain?

Shall I ring beforehand?

If you want to leave a message for the chaplain before you go into hospital then please ring St Anthony of Padua Church - 01865 762964 - to speak to the RC Chaplain (or leave a message for him on the answerphone asking him to ring back) This should ensure that he is aware of your admission to hospital.

What happens when you are in hospital?

When you are admitted into hospital you should be asked if you would like to receive a visit from the chaplain. If the message gets through then the chaplain would normally endeavor to make contact with you usually within a few days.

Not seen the chaplain yet?

Don't be afraid to ask the nurse to **'Please call the switchboard and ask them to radio page the RC Chaplain.'**

The chaplain is available 24 hours and will respond immediately by phoning the ward or telephone number given and either speak with the nurse or to the person who has made the request.

To contact the Roman Catholic Chaplain direct ring one of the following numbers and ask the operator to -

'Please radio page the RC Chaplain and ask him to ring this number (the number you are ringing from)'
